PRAY, GIVE, GO

Monday, Nov. 10

Slowly read Revelation 7:9-11. This is Christ's endgame in this world. Christ invented the church as the means to achieve this end. Pray for the Lord to give us his heart for the nations that we may bring Him His just reward.

Tuesday, Nov. 11

The Moroccans of Essaouira, Morocco are an Unreached People Group (UPG). Pray for the gospel to spread throughout the city, for more missionaries, for many to be saved, and for churches to be planted. Consider learning more about this UPG at joshuaproject.net.

Wednesday, Nov. 12

The Lord is calling us to increasingly use compassion ministries to reach the 80/20 corridor with the gospel. This includes our Wednesday ministry to students in Mesquite ISD, our hygiene kit and student-parent ministries in Forney ISD, our Forney area food distribution ministry, and our ESL ministry. Pray for the Lord to give us a heart of compassion and generosity for those in need.

Thursday, Nov. 13

We are planting Valor Church to reach the 101,000 US military personnel at Joint Base Pearl Harbor with the gospel. Our church plant opened in August 2025 and is led by Pastor Craig Coppenbarger and his wife, Maggie. Pray for the Lord to continue performing this miracle and bless the Coppenbarger family.

Friday, Nov. 14

As we celebrate the birth of Christ next month, let's fund the gift He desires the most—the salvation of the nations. We will collect our annual Greatest Gift to Jesus Missions Offering on Sunday, Dec. 7. Ask the Lord if he wants you to participate in this offering over and above your regular tithe and, if so, how much He wants you to give Him. By His grace, last year, we collected over \$750,000!

Saturday, Nov. 15

One of our overseas gospel partners, Ross and Abigail Moore and their children, are serving in a closed country in North Africa. As they finish their third year, pray for spiritual protection, language acquisition, more team members, and their transition to the city where they will live.

Sunday, Nov. 16

We are in a 21-day season of prayer for renewed passion for local evangelism and global missions. The apostle Paul made the following personal prayer request to his fellow church members. Would you imitate Paul and make it your own personal prayer request as well? "To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints, and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak." (Ephesians 6:18b-20)

Monday, Nov. 17

The Lord continues to call us to use sports as a central component of our church's evangelism strategy. This includes Upward Sports, our Fitness Center, teen and adult leagues, and sports mission trips overseas. Pray for the Lord to bless these ministries and their leaders so that doors would be opened to spread the gospel among unbelievers.

Tuesday, Nov. 18

Pray for the spread of the gospel among the Koreans of North Korea and the younger generations of South Koreans. Pray for the Lord to empower and embolden the underground churches and pastors of North Korea, where Christians are severely persecuted. Pray for the highly secularized younger generations of South Korea to respond to the gospel.

Wednesday, Nov. 19

Pray for those in our church family whom the Lord is calling to move overseas as missionaries. Pray for them to surrender decisively to His call and lock it in. Pray for them to have great faith in the Lord and take the next steps. Pray for the Lord to deliver them from the evil one. Pray for them to have strong, active support from godly church members.

Thursday, Nov. 20

The greatest global crisis of our day is lostness. Every second of every day, two humans die. The vast majority enter eternal separation from the Lord in hell. Yet the Lord desires none to perish, but for all to come to know the truth. We collect our annual Greatest Gift to Jesus Missions Offering each Christmas to give over and above our regular tithe to solve the great crisis of our day. Please pray and ask the Lord how much He wants you to give to the offering on Sunday, **Dec. 7**.

Friday, Nov. 21

One of our overseas gospel partners, Matt and Evelyn Podge and their children, serve in South Korea. As they finish their stateside assignment here in the US and prepare to return overseas, pray for a fresh filling of the Spirit and a fresh anointing, their transition back to South Korea, their spiritual protection, and their church planting work.

Saturday, Nov. 22

Christ's vision for FBC Forney to reach the 80/20 corridor with the gospel is for us to plant a family of churches along the corridor, own and operate a community center for large-scale compassion ministries, and own and operate a K-12th-grade, distinctly Christian school. Would you spend time praying the Lord's vision for us into reality?

Sunday, Nov. 23

As we continue in 21 days of prayer for a greater passion for local evangelism and global missions, would you meditate on Romans 10:13-15: "For 'everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.' How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, 'How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!'" Would you ask the Lord to give you a greater heart for the nations?

Monday, Nov. 24

Two of our overseas partners are Jack and Amber Heath and Kobe and Cadence Clay, along with their children, serving together in SE Africa. As they serve among multiple Muslim Unreached People Groups, pray for doors to open for the spread of the gospel. Pray for the spiritual protection of these two families, encouragement, fresh anointing, and their church planting efforts. Pray for wisdom for Jack Heath as he is responsible for church planting strategies and missionaries in over 10 countries.

Tuesday, Nov. 25

Each year, we leverage the Christmas Eve and Easter Sunday holidays to spread the gospel among cultural Christians on the 80/20 corridor. As these unsaved neighbors become more secularized, the opportunity to utilize these annual holidays to reach them with the gospel will end. Pray for the Lord to bless these evangelism efforts and to save many people this coming Christmas Eve and Easter Sunday.

Wednesday, Nov. 26

Our annual Greatest Gift to Jesus Missions Offering is one week from this Sunday. What if the Lord put it in our hearts to collectively give a historic \$1,000,000 offering? 100% of this offering goes to missions, so just imagine the eternal impact of such an offering! Please pray and ask the Lord how much He wants you to give over and above your regular tithe to this offering on Sunday, **Dec. 7**.

Thursday, Nov. 27

The Makonde and Mwani of Mozambique are both Muslim Unreached People Groups (UPGs). Pray for the gospel to spread throughout the region, for more missionaries, for many to be saved, and for churches to be planted. Consider learning more about these UPGs at joshuaproject.net.

Friday, Nov. 28

The term, "persecuted church", refers to our brothers and sisters in Christ around the world who experience hostility because of their faith in Christ. Persecution can range from rejection by family and loss of jobs to physical beatings, imprisonment, and death. The Lord instructs us to "Remember those in prison as if you were together with them in prison, and those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering" (Hebrews 13:2). Pray for our brothers and sisters to be delivered from persecution, to trust in the sufficiency of the Lord's grace, to be renewed in their faith, and to have strong godly friendships. Saturday, Nov. 29

The International Mission Board (IMB) and the North American Mission Board (NAMB) are our church family's primary missionary sending partners. Both are owned, operated, and fully funded by the national network of churches to which FBC Forney belongs. Together, they facilitate the efforts of our network's thousands of missionaries and church planters across our nation and around the world. Pray for the Lord to bless these organizations and their presidents, Paul Chitwood (IMB) and Kevin Ezell (NAMB).

Sunday, Nov. 30

As we close out our 21 days of prayer for renewed passion for local evangelism and global missions, would you meditate on the Great Commission: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." (Matthew 28:19-20) Would you spend time praying for a fresh passion to be a disciple-maker from our city to the ends of the earth?
